AltaOne members can do fee free withdrawals at over 35,000 ATMs nationwide. CO-OP ATMs can be located by using the CO-OP ATM Locator on AltaOne’s website at AltaOne.org; at CO-OP’s website at co-opatm.org; or by downloading the CO-OP ATM app available for iPhone and Android.

This fall AltaOne will implement CO-OP’s Shared Branch network, giving members additional, in-person access to their accounts at more than 5,700 branches in the US and several foreign countries.
